Penn-Trafford High School Homecoming Rules and Regulations

- Homecoming tickets are open to all High School grades (9-12).
- Tickets are \$25 each.
- The dance begins at 7:30. Doors will not be opened until 7:25.
- Students are permitted to leave the dance at 10:00, NO EARLIER, unless there is proof of extenuating circumstances.
- The dance officially ends at 10:30.
- No student on the Restricted List will be permitted to purchase a ticket OR attend the dance.
- Any student placed on the Restricted List for any reason MUST make up the obligations BEFORE ticket sales are completed unless prior arrangements have been made through administration or the Student Union Advisor.
- Tickets will ONLY be sold during the week and a half before the dance.
- The exchange of tickets from one student to another without permission from administration or the Student Union Advisor is NOT permitted.
- Tickets are only refundable with proof of extenuating circumstances.
- Any student who does not attend Penn-Trafford High School regularly (either in person, eAcademy or homeschooled) is considered an Outside Guest.
- Outside Guests are permitted but must be under the age of 21 and be able to provide proof of age and identification.

- Outside Guest forms must be completed in entirety, with proof of age and/or identification attached, to be able to receive a ticket during the week and a half of ticket sales. Tickets must be purchased by the Penn-Trafford student.
- Outside Guest forms are available in the Main Office, room 141 and can be printed from the school website before tickets go on sale.
- The dress code is formal. Suits and ties are expected, as well as formal women's attire.
- High-heeled shoes are not permitted to be worn in the gymnasium.
- No alcohol, drugs, weapons or outside food or beverages are permitted at the dance.
- Any student who enters the dance under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be punished accordingly.
- Any student(s) caught entering the dance without a ticket or through any door but the Nurse's entrance will be considered trespassing and a police report will be filed.
- Any student caught aiding in the entrance of a student(s) who did not purchase a ticket will also be punished accordingly.
- There will be no professional photography provided at the dance.
- Homecoming gifts are first come first served, therefore sizes and availability are not guaranteed.
- Penn-Trafford High School is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
- Any personal items brought to the dance will be subject to a search.
